Do you think this agreement would be legally binding? Should it be?

Cinderella's godmother, FG, becomes very well known as a stylist after people learn about the magical transformation she achieved for Cinderella, and she can charge large amounts of money to clients who want to achieve the perfect look for work or social events at the Palace or elsewhere. No-one else does such a good job of styling in the whole Kingdom. FG trains up a team of helpers who are similarly able to create magical effects. One client of FG's, Aurora, agrees with FG on the phone on December 1 that for the calendar year beginning the following January 1 she will use FG's styling services exclusively. FG sends Aurora a text message confirming the agreement but Aurora does not respond. FG spends a lot of time planning a series of looks for Aurora, and sends these to Aurora at the end of December, but Aurora just sends them back and then phones FG to say she has changed her mind and is going to manage without a stylist for a while.
